Handling crisis is an important topic in youth work as inappropriate handling may result in pain, suffering, fear and sometimes loss of life amongst our clients. School personnels are not only faced with a seemingly unending escalation of workload but also have to handle crisis resulting from emotional and behavioural disturbances of the students. To facilitate their work with youth, it is imperative that school personnels and professionals working with youth can be better informed of crisis management in their work setting.

In this case conference, emphasis is put on concepts of crisis intervention through case discussion and sharing. Participants are requested to bring along case example for discussion and practical applications.

Speakers / Moderators:

Mrs. LU CHAN Ching-chuen is currently the Senior Clinical Psychologist of Correctional Services Department responsible for the administration and overall development of the psychological services. As an experienced practitioner in the field of forensic psychology, she is active in contributing her expertise in forensic psychology to the community and has served on advisory committees in various organizations related to drug and crime prevention and youth work. With crisis intervention and suicide prevention being an integral part of her work, Mrs. Lu will be able to share with the participants her experiences in the field.

She specialises in Parent Education, Understanding children and families, Guidance and Counselling, School Counselling, Crisis Management, Suicidal Prevention, Assertive Training, Stress Management and Effective communication.
