<u>Keynote Speaker:</u> **Prof. Robert Ladouceur** *School of Psychology, Laval University, Quebec Canada*

Robert Ladouceur, Ph.D., is a professor of psychology at Laval University in Quebec City, Canada. After his doctoral studies, he completed post-doctoral fellow at Temple University in Philadelphia, US and at Geneva University in Switzerland.

His work on gambling is internationally known. He was invited twice to present his work at the National Gambling Impact Study Commission, the presidential U.S. commission on gambling. In 1996, he received the Research Award from National Council on Problem Gambling, recognizing the high quality of his work. In 2003, he received the Senior Research Award, from the National Center for Responsible Gaming, Harvard University.

He presented his work in many Canadian provinces, American states and European countries such as Switzerland, France, Spain, Italy, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. His cognitive treatment for pathological gamblers developed at Laval University is being widely used. He recently published a paper on Responsible Gambling, called the Reno Model, with Alex Blaszczynski, from University of Sydney, Australia and Howard Shaffer, from Harvard University.

During his academic career he has published 300 articles in peer review journals, presented over 400 papers and edited 6 books. His recent book entitled 'Understanding and Treating Problem Gamblers' was published in the U.S. and the U.K. by Wiley.

Dr. Leung has over 20 years experience working as a clinical psychologist with compulsive gamblers using CBT and has been researching with gamblers since 1978. She has presented papers in UK conferences and abroad and is lecturing and teaching locally on the topic of gambling. Dr. Leung, Honorary Assistant Professor, Acting director PDCC, is also teaching at HKU related to counseling, clinical psychology and research. She is also a clinical consultant in Even Centre for treatment of pathological gamblers in TWGHs.

Vice Principal, St. Joseph's College

Mr. Ip obtained his bachelor degree at the University of Hong Kong, majoring in Sociology and Business Administration. After graduation, he started his teaching career at St. Joseph's College, where he received his secondary education. He taught English, Religion, and Business. During that period, he finished his Diploma and Master of Education. Presently, he is the Vice Principal of the school. He has been involving in teaching and supportive works including student guidance & counseling, ethics, civil education and extra curriculum activities for more than ten years. Public duties include Member of Social Security Appeal Board, SWD, Member of Subject Committee (Religion) in HKEAA and Member of Advisory Committee on Placement of Pupils, EMB.

RSW, HK; Certified Trainer of Gambling Counselors, CCPC

Dr. Wong is a trainer of certified courses on gambling counseling at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. She actively engages in gambling research, practice and consultancy. She participated in the gambling surveys commissioned by the government in 2001, and is currently a researcher of another government commissioned service evaluation of the two treatment centres funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club. She has local and international publication on gambling issues, and was a reviewer of Journal of Gambling Studies.
