Those prolonged activities bring a lot of harmful effect to the adolescents both psychologically and physically. In this workshop, we would like to explore the cause of adolescent internet addiction, and gain ways to deal with the addictive behavior.

- 1. To understand adolescent's needs underlying their addictive behavior
- 2. To gain some strategies and skills to help the addictive students in the school context
